

Easy Access – Getting to Brighton is easy, wherever you're from

By Air

London Gatwick International Airport is the second largest airport in the UK and the seventh busiest international airport in the world. Around 90 airlines operate from Gatwick's two terminals, serving around 230 destinations. The airport is located 45 km north of Brighton and can be reached in half an hour by either road or rail (a railway station is located inside the airport terminal). There is also a half hourly National Express coach service direct to Brighton.

London Heathrow Airport is the world's busiest international airport. Regarded as the hub of the aviation world, around 90 airlines have made Heathrow their base. The airport has four terminals (with a fifth under construction) and serves over 180 destinations in over 90 countries. It is 90 minutes drive from Brighton using the motorway, or just under two hours using underground train to London Victoria railway station, and the fast express train service to Brighton. There is also a half hourly direct National Express coach service to Brighton.

By Coach

National Express offers a direct service between Brighton and both Heathrow and Gatwick Airports, with a coach service every half hour. There is also a direct service to London Victoria Coach Station.

By Rail

The city of Brighton is well connected to the rest of the UK by an extensive rail network, and is only 49 minutes from London Victoria railway station in the heart of the capital. There are also direct services from the North West, the Midlands, the West Country and South Wales. In addition, there are numerous journey options available traveling via London.

By Road

There is good access to the rest of the UK via the M23 which connects Brighton with the M25 London Orbital. Journey time by car from the centre of London is about 2 hours.

By Sea

Delegates wishing to travel from mainland Europe to Brighton have the option of using one of the many ferries to Britain.

Brighton is Britain's closest conference venue to the Continent, being approximately 2 hours driving time from the ferry ports of Dover and Folkestone, and only 30 minutes from Newhaven.

By Tunnel

European delegates now have the option of travelling on the 'Eurostar' service to Kings Cross St Pancras where there is a direct train service to

Brighton. Cars can be brought over by 'Le Shuttle' to Folkestone (channel crossing time only 35 minutes).

Public Transport within the City

The Brighton & Hove Bus & Coach Company (www.buses.co.uk) run a fleet of around 280 state-of-the-art modern buses on local bus services, running on biodiesel a low sulphur fuel. The award winning METRO network of the five most popular routes crossing the city run every few minutes during the daytime, and at night there are two all night bus routes providing convenient bus services 24 hours a day. A new satellite based vehicle tracking system enables real time departure information to be displayed at many of the city's main bus stops and on the website www.citytransport.org.uk for every bus stop in the city. This website, the first of its kind in Europe, also shows in 'real time' the congestion hot-spots, current road works and number of parking spaces available, allowing travellers to make an informed choice about their journey.
